GM Sonksen went on to present details of a telephone call received from Linda Lowney regarding the project. The project would consist of 1) Volunteers taking pictures using the Billion Graves app which geo-locates graves; 2) Event to take place June 25th from 7am to 10am; 3) Event organizers would organize volunteers, train them, and direct them in pairs to certain parts of the cemetery; 4) Organizers would enforce any rules/practices the Board would see fit; and, 5) People without phones would be used to clean around gravesites of flowers, grass, and debris and provide umbrella’s for shading.

As provided in the Ralph M. Brown Act, Government Code Section 54956.9(d)(2) the Board went into closed session at 1:55 p.m. The Board came out of closed session at 2:23 p.m.
